Share the trail

Multiple use trails are successful when users cooperate and follow established guidelines. Conflicts may be avoided by showing courtesy to each other and developing an ethic by which all users work together to share the trail.

All users

Stay on designated trails. Avoid trail use in wet conditions. Leave no trace.

Get involved. Volunteer some of your time to trail maintenance or cleanup.

Hikers

Keep pets leashed and under control.

Bikers

Control your speed.
Avoid skidding – skidding shows poor form, sloppy technique, and causes erosion Wear a helmet.

Carry a first aid kit and tools. At least a patch kit, pump, and chain tool. Carry water and snacks.

Encountering other bikers

Downhill riders should yield to uphill riders. Be considerate of novices and family groups.

Bikers encountering hikers

Bikers yield to all other trail users. A friendly greeting makes a positive impression. Announce your presence when overtaking hikers.

Equestrians and motorized vehicles are not allowed.
